



Sangria Aromas de Turis

100% Garnacha

Intensely fruity aroma that explodes with freshness and flavours of ripe red fruit, cinnamon and hints of orange blossom. Better yet the wine is not overly sweet, making it a joy to drink. This Sangria is produced like wine and during fermentation lemons and soft fruit that are grown within the vines are added, giving the natural fruitiness to the wine. A hint of soda is added at the end to keep the wine fresh.

This wine matches perfectly with a hot sunny day on the deck after a game of golf, at a cocktail party or with appetizers. Make it look pretty by serving it in a glass jug with slices of citrus and ice.

Sangria also makes great "mulled wine."

VINEYARD NOTES



- In 1920, 70 Vine Growers joined together to collaborate to make a better wine.
- Today those 70 vine growers are still the farming partners and produce most of the grapes for the La Baronia de Turis wines, even though today they now have 713 farming partners.
- The 70 vine growers work the fields every day and receive direction and inspected by La Baronia de Turis. The other members are very small, they only have 1 or 2 fields and work during the weekends, but are under the same obligations as the 70 vine growers.
- All the grape growers are partners, they only grape grow for La Baronia de Turis.
- They must abide to all the control and quality process that is given by the 8 Board of Directors, 1 President (which is a farmer that is the representative for all farmers) and Ana Calvet (Managing Director and oenologist for La Baronia de Turis).
- La Baronia de Turis have control from the vineyards, to the grapes to the making of the wine.
- La Baronia de Turis is ISO 9001, supporting quality management system and both IFS (Standard International Food) and BRC (British Retail Consortium).
- Valencia has over 500 km of stunning coastline, the region is extremely beautiful and very fertile area known as La Huerta (Garden of Spain).
- Valencia is the capital of the province and the name of the region.
- Valencia is known for its sweet muscatels and fantastic, solid every day wines at amazing prices.
- The wine cellar is situated in Turis which is situated in the central area of the Mediterranean coast from the Iberian Peninsula at about 320 metres above sea level.
