Wine in the Sack Syrah

- 19 years vine age
- 5.25 tons per acre
- Aged 9 months in stainless steel tanks, 3 months in the bottle
- 5,000 cs produced

Intense ruby red color with complex notes of wild strawberry marmalade, pepper-tobacco and vanilla. Mature tannins create a well-rounded palate with a medium-bodied and pleasant finish.

Wine in the Sack Cabernet Sauvignon

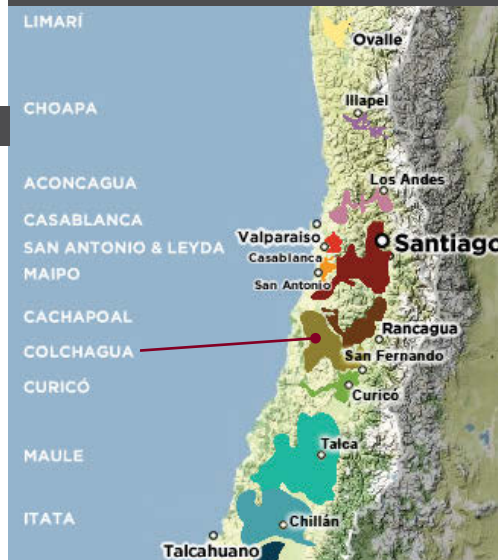
- 19 years vine age
- 5.25 tons per acre
- Aged 10 months in stainless steel tanks, 2 months in the bottle
- 10,000 cs produced

Dark, violet red. Aromatic profile features fresh and dried cherry plus dried plum with intriguing notes of dark chocolate and mint. On the palate, the wine is rich, well balanced and approachable with a long smooth finish.

VINEYARD NOTES



- At first the wine was bottled in sturdy 15 litre earthenware chucos.
- The Franciscan monks that lived near the winery (over 100 years ago) discovered that burlap sacks protected the new “small” glass bottles from breakage during their bumpy trip by horse-drawn cart.
- The idea of wrapping the bottles with burlap caught on with the winery and became a tradition that has endured to this day.
- Each bottle is wrapped by hand, as well as the application of the labels.
- All wines are hand harvested.
