**Temple Bruer has the following certifications, which guarantee third party accountability:**

- **ISO 9001** (Quality Management Certification)
- **HACCP** (Hazards Analysis and Critical Control Points); a set of guidelines and principles that offer a systematic approach to food safety
- **Certified Organic (EU Standard)**. One difference compared to the Australian certification is the EU standard for SO<sub>2</sub>, which is 100 ppm vs 250 ppm
- Joined the **Australian Govs. Greenhouse Challenge** program in 2002 to be Greenhouse neutral by 2010

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## VINEYARD NOTES

- David & Barbara bought 50 acres in 1973
- Both are chemists & both taught at the Roseworthy College; David was in charge of the Oenology Department
- 1993 began the conversion of organic farming
- No synthetic chemicals at any stage of the grape growing & later winemaking
- David & employees take environmental stewardship as seriously as they do their grape & wine production
- Temple Bruer is regarded as a leader in organic vineyard & wine scene, used as the "model" for organic farming in Australia
- As of August 2011 all of Temple Bruer's products & activities are Carbon Neutral
- Annual rainfall is 410mm
- Deep alluvial silt & sand over red clay & limestone

### Langhorne Creek Notes

- Regarded as one of the best-kept secrets in Australian Viticulture
- The area was founded on the broad flood plain influenced by the local Bremer & Angas Rivers & dominated by magnificent River Red Gums

- The name Langhorne Creek acknowledges Alfred Langhorne, a cattle drover during the 1840's
- The wine region has a proud history of family owned & run vineyards & wineries



- Known for its ability to produce consistent, high quality bold red wines
- Access to water, coupled with cooling breezes from Lake Alexandrina that reduce evening temperatures makes it an ideal growing region
